I highly recommend watching the video (mostly because I'm so proud of it!). But here are some basic step by step notes for when you just want a quick glance to remind you of the process:

Preparing the Image

- 1. Choose an image you already have or take a photo.
- 2. Crop out anything large that you don't want in the photo.
- Shift the image within the cropped space to about where you want it in your final collage. Not pictured, but I shifted Noelle so she's more to the right than centered.




Collage Pattern



Lightweight Interfacing Taped in Place






Choosing Colors

 Pick most of your fabrics first and make sure they look good together before cutting out shapes

 Make sure your background contrasts with your collage so your collage pops.





Prepping Fabrics










Marking/Cutting/Gluing/Piecing







Gluing/Tracing Tricks




These are **not glued** down; **just glued to each other**. Don't glue until you have the section done so you can see the next part you need to trace.

Gluing the center only at first helps you tuck fabric under/layer things later if you need to



Layering:

- Collage pieces MUST
 be layered (not side by
 side or the backing
 fabric will show)
- Extend the size of the fabric piece underneath 1/8" 1/4" larger than its pattern piece (keep the same size/shape for what is layered on top)



Layering:


Collage pieces **MUST** be layered (not side by side or the backing fabric will show).

Extend the size of the fabric piece underneath 1/8" - 1/4" larger

Fix Mistakes



Glue still wet: just peel off

Glue dried: use water then peel off

Remove the Paper/ Trim the Collage

Peel off the paper (normal for some of it to stick because of the glue). Trim the edges of the interfacing 1/4" behind the collage edge if you can. I don't have good photos! So come ask me if you get stuck



Pick a Background













Prep your Quilt Sandwich

- 1. Glue collage to background fabric.
- 2. Sandwich your three layers.
- Try not to pin the collage to batting/backing

Pin the background fabric/batting/backing


